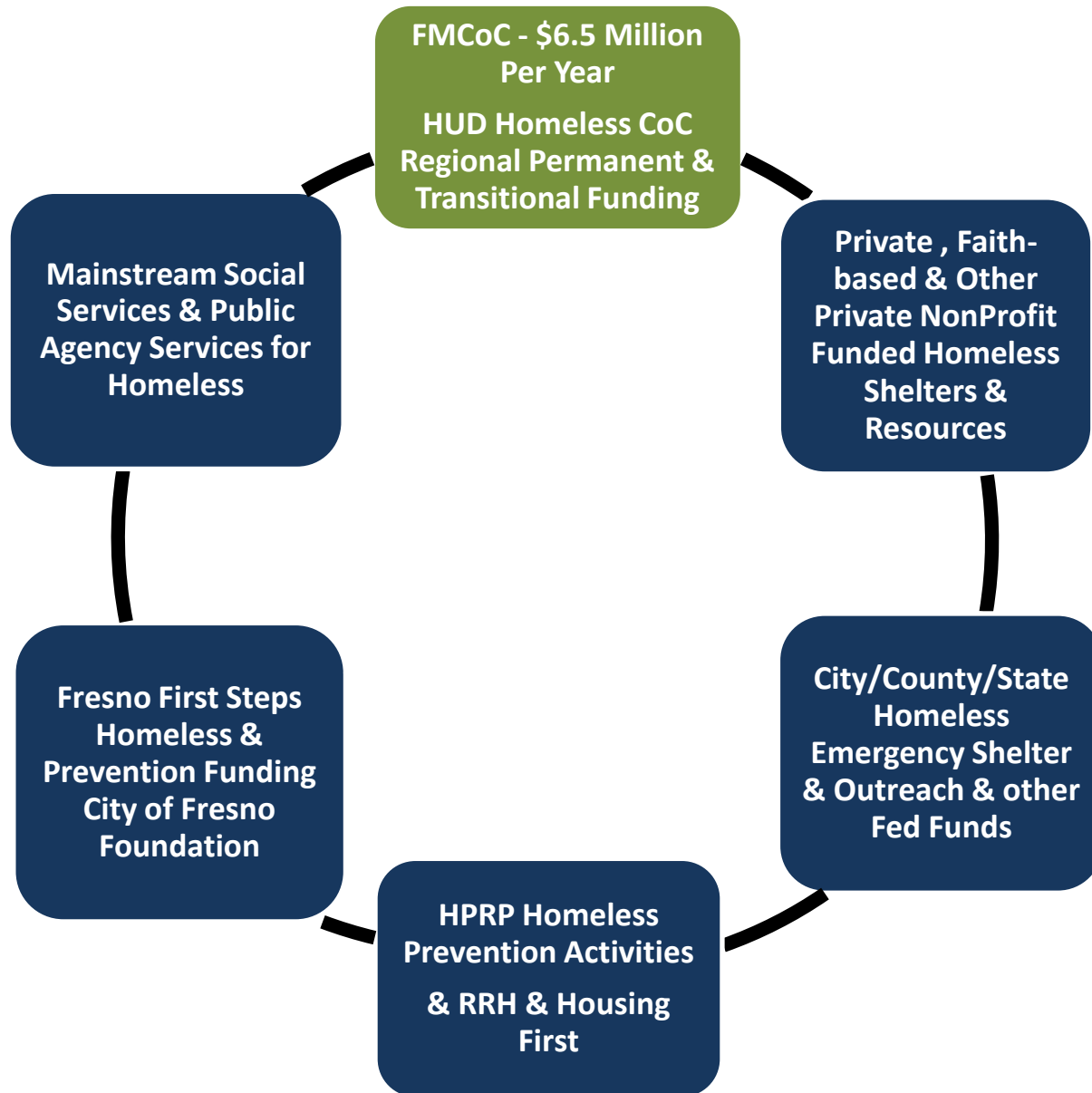


Addressing Homelessness in Fresno



The above graph represents the critical connection of each separate homeless activity. Each area of funding / service is relative & necessary to address the entire homeless picture; while the non-directional relationship depicts each component as equally important, without hierarchy, yet required to fulfill the homeless system-service need. The FMCoC critical activity (Point-In-Time Homeless count; HMIS; annual unmet need & service gaps identification) is the means to attain the (\$6.5 million of annual) HUD Homeless Funding for the entire region. Therefore it must ensure the efficient and effective connection of each specific activity to fulfill the CoC overall goal to end homelessness. The FMCoC is accountable to HUD on 10-Year Plan achievements in the Annual HUD HOMELESS Funding Competition.
