2022 HUD Community Workshops

At A Glance

HUD is excited to announce the next round of **Community Workshop**, running from February through June 2022! Community Workshops are:

• 12-week workshops which allow communities to access direct TA through an online, group learning, peer-to-peer collaborative approach with built-in 1-on-1 support from facilitators. • Designed to support CoC and ESG recipients to make strategic decisions to aid rehousing efforts.

• Designed to expand communities' understanding of how to advance racial equity in their homelessness response system.

The following topics are being offered in the next round of workshops:

- Building Community-Wide Support for Housing Focused Practices
- Coordinated Entry: Prioritization and Assessment
- Coordinated Entry: Referral Best Practices
- Partnering with People with Lived Experience
- System Performance Improvement using Stella P

Specific time and logistics are tailored to each topic-specific workshop, but the following is a general overview of expectations:

- Pre-work will need to occur before sessions start (~1-6 hours)
- Participation in 3-session Equity Foundational Workshop as prerequisite for all topics (~10 hours over 3 weeks)
- Attendance of virtual sessions over the three-month period (5-6 sessions depending on topic, 90 mins per session)
- Participation in TA 1-on-1 support between sessions (~30-60 mins between each session)
- Practice of skills learned and completion of specific assignments between sessions (~1-6 hours between each session)

Communities should have 2 to 4 participants for the workshop. Some workshops may have data or technical requirements for participation.
