Marcella Lopez-Schmidt: Annual Refresher Sign-up Process

- 2 HMIS training per month: 1 for New Users and 1 for Annual Refreshers
- Abby, the HMIS Trainer, will send a list of the staff that need HMIS Annual Training, and the Agency Administrator will need to complete a Microsoft form. Those who completed a Microsoft form and signed a billing verification form/confirmed invoice will be enrolled in the Annual Refresher Training for the next month.

Rogelina Lopez: Data Quality Presentation

- Introduced the HUD EVA tool that helps assess data quality across the system
- The committee decided on the 2024 data quality benchmark.
 - By the end of the reporting period (09/30/2024), reduce the yearly number of high-priority and error-level issues by **45** percent.
 - 2023 # of High-priority and error-level issue count was 14,401
 - The Final Target will be 7,920 errors
- Acknowledgment to Centro La Familia and RH Community/ Elevate Community Services for their Data Quality Improvements.
- The goal is to merge the Action Camp and Data Quality Meetings into one in the future.

Marcella Lopez-Schmidt: 2023 System Performance Measure Report – How did we do? What’s the plan for 2024?

- The seven measures – went through all of the measure data from 2023 in comparison to 2022 and 2021
- Length of stay – data quality element (Housing Move-In Dates can affect this)
- Return to Homelessness – increase of people that return to homeless from 2022 to 2023 – stabilization is complex due to chronicity and market availability
- Change in income – income increased for stayers but decreased for leavers
- Successful PH Placement and Retention – successful placement and retention -
 - Action Item: The HMIS team will monthly email Emergency Shelter entries to street outreach projects to improve this measure.
